Preface

ILO Better Factories Cambodia works together with Joint UN Millennium Development Goals Programme for Children, Food Security and Nutrition to improve maternal health in Cambodia

The Joint Programme operates in provinces of Svay Rieng and Kampong Speu. ILO-BFC works closely with the Provincial Departments of Labour in awareness raising activities through behavior change communications on breastfeeding, complementary feeding, and Iron Folic Acid supplementation for lactating and post partum women. The photos highlight a number of activities performed by Labour Departments of Svay Rieng and Kampong Speu includes training on Maternity protection, Occupational Safety and Health, Importance of Breast milk, and issues pertaining to reproductive health (family planning).

The Joint UN Millennium Development Goals Programme for Children, Food Security and Nutrition in Cambodia contributes to the achievement of three Millennium Development Goals: MDG 1 - eradicating extreme poverty and hunger, MDG 4 - reducing child mortality, and MDG 5 - improving maternal health. The International Labour Organisation (ILO) as a partner in the Joint Programme, is addressing issues related to maternal protection/health, children, food security and nutrition in cooperation with, Ministry of Labour, Trade Unions, and Employers.

II. Training delivered by Department of Labour and Vocational Training

a. Svay Rieng:



23 December 2010: Svay Rieng Provincial Department of Labour and Vocational Training and Provincial Health Department provided workshop on Maternity Protection with focuses on maternal and child health, food security and nutrition, importance of milk breastfeeding, and Occupational Safety and Health. There were 25 (23 female) workers and management representatives from Las Vegas Sun Casino and Hotel attending the training.



02 January 2011: Svay Rieng DoLVT conducted a meeting and workshop session on 7 important points of Roles and Responsibilities of OSH Committee and session on Occupational Safety and Health focusing on OSH Management System, Building Safety Culture, Work-Related Accidents, Injuries Prevention and Unsafe Management. 333 workers (257 females) are watching TV sports on first hour breastfeeding and nutrition at Atlantic Cycle Factory.

b. Kampong Speu:



31 March 2011: Kampong Speu Labour Department provided a training on Reproductive Health focusing on breast milk expressing and family planning for garment workers from Sangwoo Garment. There were 29 female workers attending.



30 November 2010: Kampong Speu Provincial Department of Labour and Vocational Training offered Workshop on OSH and Maternity Protection for enterprise's physicians and medical staff. There were 22 enterprises' physicians and medical staff attending.

III. OSH Inspections by Provincial Departments of Labour of Kampong Speu and Svay Rieng



Drinking water and drinking place at one of the factories monitored by Provincial Labour Inspector. Based on the service agreement between ILO BFC and Provincial Labour Departments. The Labour Departments of Svay Rieng and Kampong Speu shall conduct 5 and 4 OSH inspections respectively. Prakas 054/00 requires that the drinking water must be put in a clean container with a closed lid and a tap. The employer must provide hygienic cups for drinking water.



Machine Safety: Provincial Labour Inspector inspected a factory producing helmet in Kampong Speu.



OSH Inspection: Access path (walkway) was blocked by materials and baskets.



OSH Inspection: Access path (walkway) was kept in tidy manner.
